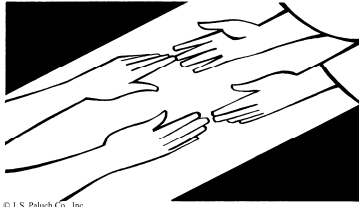

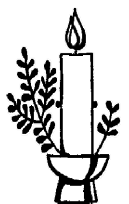

HOUSEHOLDS IN GOD’S SERVICE

In the ancient world, “household” was a wide-reaching concept. When Joshua today speaks of his household serving the Lord, he meant not just those people who lived inside his walls or those related to him by blood or marriage; he meant slaves or servants and their families, and anyone indebted to him in any way. Even his livestock and other possessions would be consecrated to service of God. In our world, we value allowing individuals their freedom to choose how they live, and wouldn’t think of offering our pets to the service of God. But, as we discern our vocation as disciples baptized into Christ, we can come to realize how far-ranging the “households” of our lives still are: how we act toward our spouses, children, roommates or anyone we live with; our behavior with neighbors; or in public as we encounter many “strangers” every day in stores or traffic who suddenly are “next door” to us. How can we use our time, our resources, or gifts for selfless reasons rather than personal gain? No matter what life our witness to the Good News calls us to, we all have a “household” that must be consecrated to service of the Lord our God.

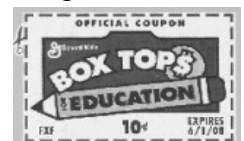

I have been asked to recruit new members for the team and feel this is an excellent communication link to East Hartford residents. As a C.E.R.T. member, you would provide support to our community, neighbors and families in time of disasters. You are trained in safety, search and rescue, medical triage, emergency preparedness, and staffing the Salvation Army truck. This is an eight week course, twenty hours basic training, 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. starting Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2009. SO YOU WANT TO BE A GODPARENT OR CONFIRMATION SPONSOR?

One of the most disappointing events that can occur is when you have been asked to be a godparent or a confirmation sponsor and you find out that you are not eligible because you have not received the sacrament of Confirmation.

If you are 18 years of age or older, a baptized Catholic who has received your First Communion but have not been confirmed, you can attend six sessions of adult education classes and then celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday, October 28, 2009 at St. Thomas Seminary Chapel in Bloomfield at 7:30 p.m. with registration at 6:30 p.m.

Classes will be held at the Archdiocesan Center at St. Thomas Seminary in Bloomfield on Tuesdays (9/15, 9/22, 9/29, 10/6, 10/13, 10/20) from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. or on Thursdays (9/17, 9/24, 10/1, 10/8, 10/15, 10/22) from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. at St. Joan of Arc in Hamden.

There is a \$15 book fee that is payable at the time of registration.
