**Living Stations of the Cross:** 7:30 pm (SC)

*The Living Stations is the dramatic presentation of our Lord's passion, death and Resurrection. Please join us as we prayerfully reflect on Christ's love for us with narrated meditation and beautiful music performed a capella.*



## Holy Saturday ~ April 20

No morning Mass is celebrated on this day.

**Blessing of Easter Foods:** 9:30 am (SC)

*After the fasting of Lent, the foods of Easter have a special place. Among the items that might be included in your Easter basket for blessing are: sweet breads/rolls, ham, butter/cheese, eggs, salt, wine. Children are encouraged to come with their own basket with colored Easter eggs, jelly beans, a chocolate bunny, etc.*

**Confessions:** 10:00 am – 12:00 noon (SC)

**The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night:** 8:00 pm (SC)

*The Easter Vigil begins in darkness. The Easter candle, lit from the Easter fire and processed into the church, lights up the darkness. We hear the stories of creation, salvation and Resurrection. We sing our songs of praise, joy and hope. This is the night above all other nights when we celebrate the boundless, creative and redemptive love of God.*
